Who’s listening?

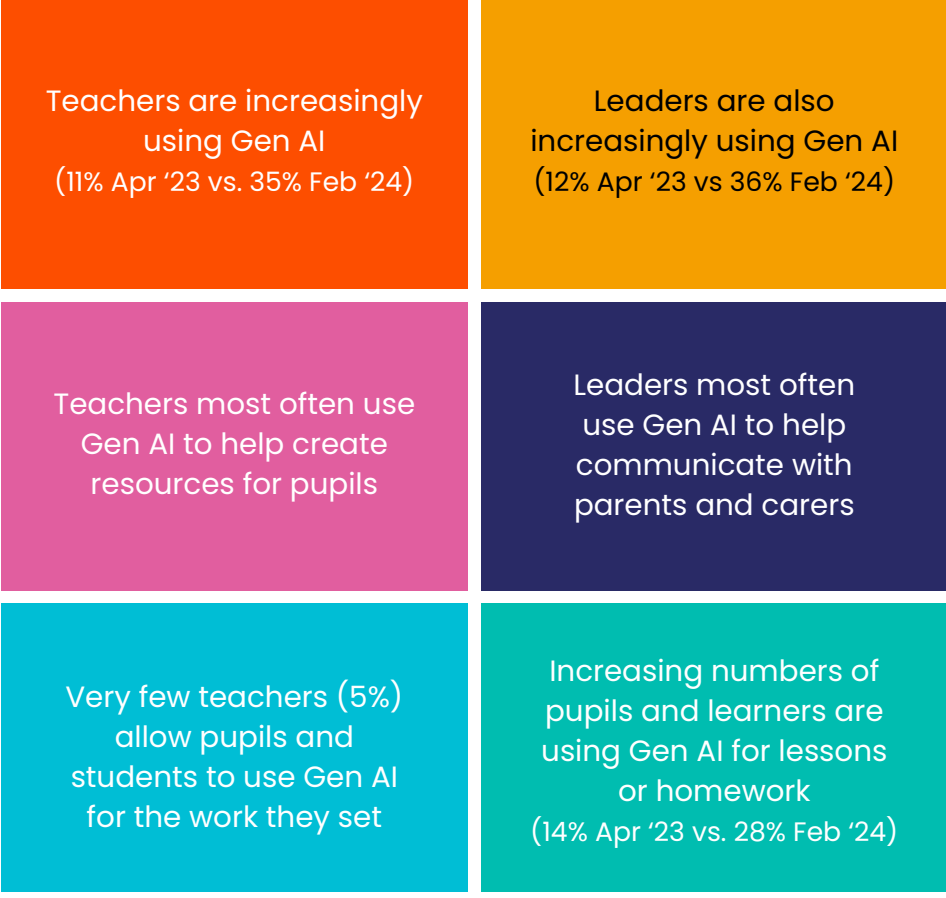

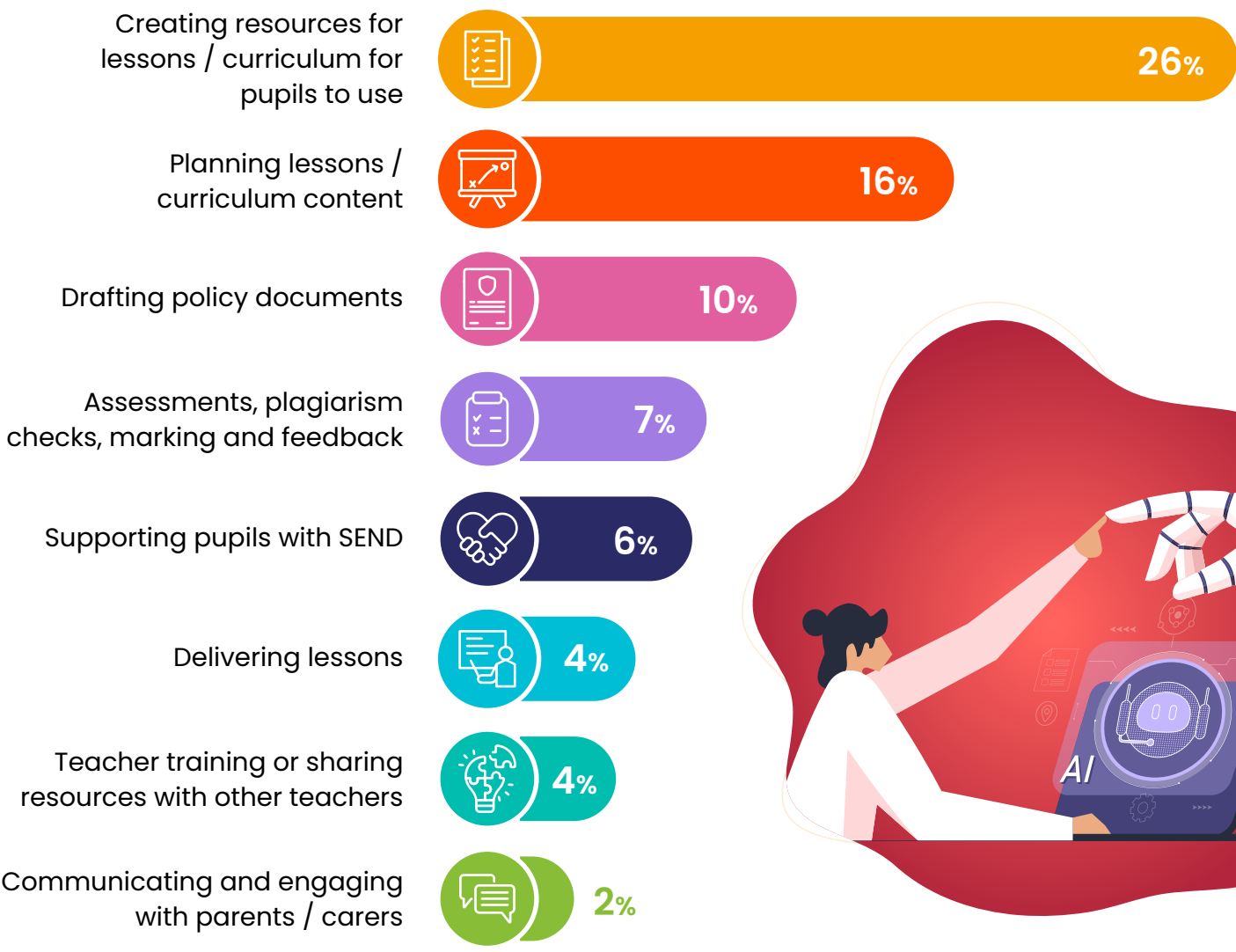
Spotlight on survey findings - the use of Generative AI in schools and colleges

For the last two years we have asked you, other teachers and leaders in SCV about how Generative AI (Gen AI) is being used. At the same time, pupils and parents have also been sharing their experiences through SCV’s sister survey, the Parent, Pupil and Learner Voice.

The findings show that everyone is using Gen AI more. And, while schools and colleges don’t often allow students to use Gen AI in the work they set, quite a lot of students are using it.

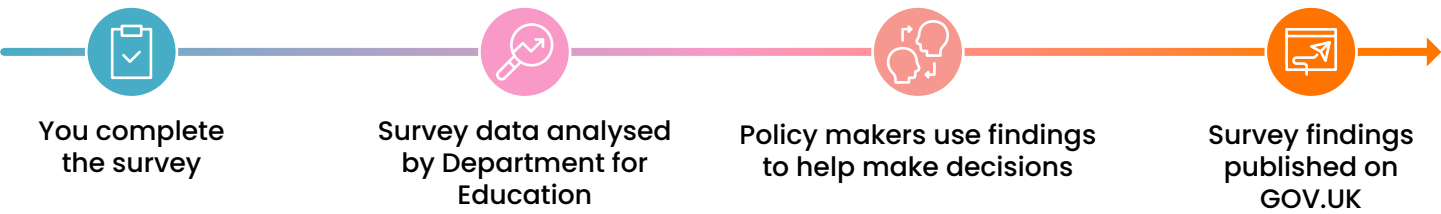


Proportion of teachers who have used Gen AI tools to support different tasks February 2024
